



Specify the measurement option before printing. Click CTRL + P (or CMD + P on Mac) to access the print page and make sure the page scale is 100%.

Measure the test pattern length with a ruler to make sure it is correct.

It should be 3 cm (30 mm) long.
























It should be 1 inch long.



Measure the size of your existing ring

Please pick a ring that fits your finger properly, you can locate your ring size by placing it on the printed rings below. When you place your ring on the printed ring, make sure that the inner part (blue rings) is completely covered with no gaps. The red ring lines should not appear when viewed from above. If your ring size is between 2 sizes, we recommend that you consider the size that is large.

You can place your credit card here to use as a scale and get accurate results.

These measurements are the inner diameter dimensions of your ring.
Please use these measurements as a reference, there may be deviations.
